Kittson County Sheriff's Report

On April 14th, 2016, received a report of a beet pulp hauler being detained and harassed east of Lancaster.

On April 14th, 2016, received a report of a juvenile inappropriately touching another juvenile in Lancaster. The juvenile was issued a citation for 1) Disorderly Conduct.

On April 14th, 2016, received a complaint from a woman in Karlstad, who stated she was assaulted. Shawn C. Donarski (38) of Karlstad, was arrested for 1) Burglary in the First Degree.

On April 15th, 2016, received a complaint of semi's blocking the roads in St. Vincent.

On April 15th, 2016, A Tobacco Compliance check was conducted at Cenex in Hallock. Daphanie J. Gage (26) and the store were each issued a penalty for the violation Sale of Tobacco to a Minor.

On April 17th, 2016, received a call that an intoxicated person needs to be evicted from his current residence. The person was removed and brought to the Gateway Motel. A few hours later, the intoxicated person came to the Kittson County Sheriff's Office, and started banging on the door and screaming. Robert W. Olson (61) of Hallock was booked into jail and was issued a citation for 1) Disorderly Conduct.

On April 17th, 2016, Christopher B. Brown (25) of Hallock was issued a citation for 1) Junk Cars/Household Appliances/Garbage.

On April 18th, 2016, at approximately 3:30 p.m. we received a complaint of an intoxicated woman in Hallock. The woman was located and proved not to be intoxicated, but was having medical issues.
