## No Confirmed Cases of COVID-19 in Kittson County

## Marshall County Resident Tested For COVID-19

In Marshall County, a Warren resident has been tested. The college student had traveled and developed symptoms upon their return. The individual was tested at Altru yesterday and tested positive for influenza. Because of the individual's travel history, Altru also tested for COVID-19. **Altru anticipates results in the next 48-hours.** Because the resident's family members work at the Marshall County Courthouse and Warren City Offices, these departments have been closed and staff are sheltering at home until the COVID-19 results are back.

## Kittson County Courthouse Locked Down

The Kittson County Courthouse has implemented a lockdown to proactively protect its employees and citizens. The courthouse is asking residents to call the individual county departments for appointments prior to visiting. Visitors with appointments should go to the north doors where they will be asked a series of COVID-19 screening questions to determine if they will be allowed to enter.
