SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS (RURAL)

1. All work shall be accomplished in a workmanship like manner.
2. All work shall be accomplished without expense to Kittson County.
3. The Applicant will be responsible for notifying the utility companies within close proximity of approved work area before commencing work.

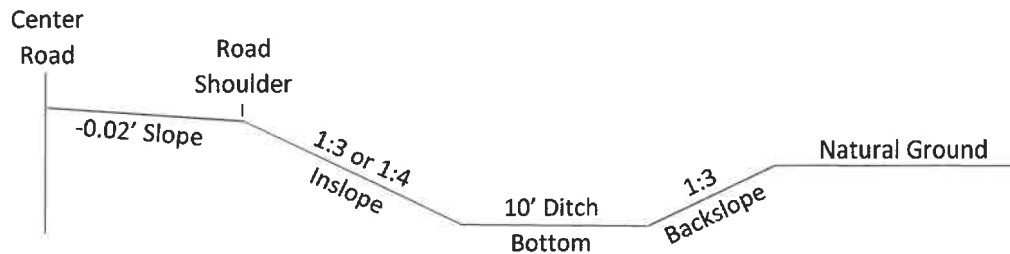

4. Where the character or condition of the work creates a hazard to the public, the applicant agrees to maintain sufficient warning signs to alert the public. Any traffic control required shall be the responsibility of the applicant and at their expense.
5. Inslopes, backslopes and ditch bottoms must be cut as indicated in the detail below:



6. Permission to clean a ditch will not be granted if the cleanout will cause a berm or dike on the adjacent property that can't be effectively and safely mowed (1:3 slope or greater).
7. Ditch cleanout must be maintenance only. Applicant must determine original grades as approved by Kittson County. Excavation can't extend below original grade.
8. Other affected landowners if any, must be informed for their approval by the applicant. By signing this application, the applicant is indicating that he has complied with this requirement.
9. In instances where farm field entrances are involved, Kittson County will determine the need and length of the culvert needed. A Watershed Permit will be required for size and elevation of the culvert.
10. When dealing with entrances, if it is determined a culvert is necessary, Kittson County may participate in the cost of the culvert material up to 40' in length if the work qualifies in accordance with the Kittson County Culvert Policy. Otherwise, all culvert material, bands, gates and aprons along with material required to properly construct the entrance are all at the expense of the applicant.

11. In instances when dealing with a culvert through a Kittson County Road, unless the culvert has failed or has been determined to be in need of replacing, all expenses are the responsibility of the applicant for all culvert material, road building material and labor to complete the project.
12. If there is any damage to the Kittson County Road due to the applicant's work, the cross section and condition of the road will be returned to its original state at the applicant's expense. A copy of the existing typical section (if available) shall be provided as a reference for the applicant to use in returning the roadway to its original construction.
13. Completion of work includes any and all cleanup measures. Any unused or waste material excavated must be disposed of properly outside of Kittson County Right-of-Way or as directed by Kittson County. Area of work shall be cleared of garbage. Pavements shall be swept of gravel/dirt residue.
14. The Kittson County Highway Department shall be notified when all work permitted by this application has been completed and until work has been approved, the applicant is still liable for said conditions of their work.
15. This permit expires 12 months after the date of authorization or may be renewed.
